#### **NOT NEXT TO ME, PLEASE!**

They also tell you about air <u>disasters</u> (which you are not interested in). The best thing to do is to pretend to sleep.

These people are not necessarily very big, but they have a terrible <u>habit</u> of taking up all their room, and some of your room, too. They usually sit so that you can't move, with their arms and legs in your space. They also have a lot of hand luggage which takes up all the room in the overhead locker.
